### Poster boards

- Size: **47" high x 85" long**
- Material: felt suitable for Velcro (not included), not suitable for pins.
- Color: royal blue or gray

If you require additional furniture (eg. table, chair, power connection), contact a Poster Session Chair **before November 5, 2010**.

### Duties:

- Poster authors must be **registered** for the conference and **in attendance at their posters** during Poster Session.
- Authors are reminded that **an abstract is required** for a poster presentation. See our website for formatting requirements and deadlines.

### Set-up and tear-down

- The poster session will take place in the lobby of the Capitol Theatre, which is the same building where the talk sessions will be held.
- A floorplan and list of authors and locations will be posted on our website in early November along with the schedule of talks. This poster location guide will also be posted in the lobby on Tuesday November 17.
- Please **set your poster up** Tuesday November 16, in the morning, after you have registered.
- **Tear down** will take place Thursday November 18, starting at 1:00. **If do not retrieve your presentation by 3:00 pm it may be discarded.**
